


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INTRODUCTION

The reports published by the Dental Admission Testing (DAT) Program are intended to provide information on Dental Admission Test examinees to different users: the Council on Dental Education and Licensure, dental educators and practitioners, state and federal agencies, and other interested individuals. The purpose of the present report is to provide general demographic information on examinees.

The self-reported demographic information was obtained during the application process on a voluntary basis. Therefore, the numbers of examinees who responded to the questionnaires vary from year to year. The information provided in this report is a summary of the data obtained during the five-year period beginning in 2004. The total represents the total number of the examinations during the calendar year. The percentage of each cell reflects that of the respondents only.

This report contains information related to gender, ethnicity, occupational and educational attainment of the parents, high school rank, college grade point average (GPA) and college science GPA, college major, extracurricular activity, parents' income, source and percentage of loans obtained during the years of dental education, and GPA and income by ethnicity.




